

BOWSER WATERWORKS DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 129

A Bylaw for fixing tolls and other charges payable to the improvement district and the terms of payment, thereof, and providing for a percentage addition to encourage prompt payment thereof.

The Trustees of the Bowser Waterworks District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following tolls are, hereby, fixed and made payable by all owners of land in the improvement district to which water is delivered from the works of the improvement district.

(a) Water rates (residential) (per quarter)

- (i) In respect of each single family dwelling;
- (ii) In respect of each additional unit (attached or detached), where each dwelling unit consists of a separately metered water supply;
- (iii) In respect of each store, office, hall, church or other place of business not attached to a family dwelling, where each dwelling unit consists of a separately metered water supply;

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 8,799 gallons	\$ 54.00
Each additional 100 gallons from 8,799 to 15,398 gallons	\$ 0.41
Each additional 100 gallons from 15,398 to 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.57
Each additional 100 gallons exceeding 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.68

or

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 40 M ³	\$ 54.00
Each additional M ³ from 40 to 70 M ³	\$ 0.90
Each additional M ³ from 70 to 100 M ³	\$ 1.25
Each additional M ³ exceeding 100 M ³	\$ 1.50

(b) Water rates (residential) (per quarter) – multiple service connections

- (i) In respect of each unit in a co-op, apartment or strata, where one metered connection services multiple dwelling units:

Minimum quarterly toll per dwelling unit for the first 8,799 gallons	\$ 54.00
Each additional 100 gallons from 8,799 to 15,398 gallons	\$ 0.41
Each additional 100 gallons from 15,398 to 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.57
Each additional 100 gallons exceeding 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.68

or

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 40 M ³	\$ 54.00
Each additional M ³ from 40 to 70 M ³	\$ 0.90
Each additional M ³ from 70 to 100 M ³	\$ 1.25
Each additional M ³ exceeding 100 M ³	\$ 1.50

(c) Water rates (residential) (per quarter) – multiple service connections

(i) In respect of each unit in a strata, where each unit consists of a metered connection:

Minimum quarterly toll per dwelling unit for the first 8,799 gallons	\$ 54.00
Each additional 100 gallons from 8,799 to 15,398 gallons	\$ 0.41
Each additional 100 gallons from 15,398 to 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.57
Each additional 100 gallons exceeding 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.68

or

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 40 M ³	\$ 54.00
Each additional M ³ from 40 to 70 M ³	\$ 0.90
Each additional M ³ from 70 to 100 M ³	\$ 1.25
Each additional M ³ exceeding 100 M ³	\$ 1.50

(d) Water rates (commercial) (per quarter) – single unit

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 8,799 gallons	\$ 54.00
Each additional 100 gallons from 8,799 to 15,398 gallons	\$ 0.41
Each additional 100 gallons from 15,398 to 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.57
Each additional 100 gallons exceeding 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.68

or

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 40 M ³	\$ 54.00
Each additional M ³ from 40 to 70 M ³	\$ 0.90
Each additional M ³ from 70 to 100 M ³	\$ 1.25
Each additional M ³ exceeding 100 M ³	\$ 1.50

(e) Water rates (commercial) (per quarter) – multiple units

(i) In respect of each unit, where each unit consists of a separate water supply

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 8,799 gallons	\$ 54.00
Each additional 100 gallons from 8,799 to 15,398 gallons	\$ 0.41
Each additional 100 gallons from 15,398 to 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.57
Each additional 100 gallons exceeding 21,997 gallons	\$ 0.68

or

Minimum quarterly toll for the first 40 M ³	\$ 54.00
Each additional M ³ from 40 to 70 M ³	\$ 0.90
Each additional M ³ from 70 to 100 M ³	\$ 1.25
Each additional M ³ exceeding 100 M ³	\$ 1.50

2. Meters will be read quarterly, at the end of March, June, September and December, and will be billed quarterly, following the reading of the meters.
3. Tolls are due and payable within thirty (30) days of the billing date. Accounts remaining unpaid thirty (30) days after the billing date shall be subject to a percentage addition of eleven percent (11%) of all tolls outstanding.

4. In addition to the aforementioned charges and tolls, there is a charge of \$50 to cover turning the water off. There is no charge for reconnection.
5. There shall be payable to the District by every owner making application for connection to the works of the district, a connection fee of \$500.00, or a charge equal to the cost of the connection, whichever is greater.
6. When a complaint regarding the efficiency of a meter is registered with the District by the water user, and the complaint proves to be unjustified, there will be a charge of \$25.00, plus the cost of having the meter removed, checked and replaced.
7. The Trustees may, by resolution, order the water shut off to any premises on which there are charges owing for ninety (90) days or longer. Water shut off under this section shall be subject to the same charges levied under Section 4 of this bylaw.
8. Severability: If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of any court, such section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase may be severed from the remaining portion of this bylaw with the remaining portions of the bylaw remaining valid and of full force and effect.
9. This bylaw may be cited as the “2009 Water Tolls Bylaw”.
10. This bylaw repeals Bylaw No. 123, passed by the Trustees on the 22nd day of April, 2008.

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 31st day of March, 2009.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed by the Trustees on the 31st day of March, 2009.
